

Appetizer - Fun for the Holidays

Party Pretzels



Ready in 20- 30 minutes

Serves 15-20 people

Ingredients

- 56 ounces UTZ Honey Wheat Pretzels
- ¾ cup Orville Redenbacher's popping and topping oil
- 3 Tbsp ranch dressing mix
- 1 Tbsp dried dill
- 1 Tbsp garlic powder

Preparation

1. Place the pretzels in a large bowl
2. Pour ¾ cup popping oil over the pretzels, mix well and let sit for 5-15 minutes
3. Mix the spices together in a small bowl
4. Mix the pretzels a few times and then add the seasoning, mix well

TIPS

Orville Redenbacher's oil is really the best for this recipe. I find these pretzels stay fresh for about 2 weeks before they start going stale. But that's in Hawaii where it's quite humid. This usually isn't a problem, because they get eaten up in no time!
